1. Advisory Safety Zone at Moray East Wind Farm

Please be advised that Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited (Moray East) have implemented and advisory 500m safety zone around WTG G11, whilst operation and maintenance vessels conduct pre works inspections and will follow with post inspection rectification works. This advisory safety zone will remain in place until further notice.

2. General Safety advice

In order to not compromise the safety of the vessel conducting the inspections and its crew, and the ability to undertake their contracted works, fishermen who have static fishing gears deployed within 500 m from the WTG (see Table 1) are requested to provide the coordinates of such deployed gears in DMS and details of whether the surface markers used are visible at all states of visibility to Alex Winrow-Griffin (Brown & May Marine) using the contact information below (Section 58 of the Merchant Shipping Act 1995).

Fishermen who have static gears deployed beyond 12 nm are reminded that static gear must be marked in accordance with Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No. 404/2011 (<https://www.gov.uk/guidance/marketing-of-fishing-gear-retrieval-and-notification-of-lost-gear#marking-of-fishing-gear>).

All mariners are requested to give a wide berth to all vessels involved in the inspections.

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution, to use all means appropriate to aid safe navigation as defined under COLREGs Rule 7, and keep continued watch on VHF Ch. 16, 87 and 73 when navigating the area.
