



Figure 1. Moray East Offshore Windfarm bounded area.

Masters of vessels are therefore requested to maintain their vessels and gears at a minimum safe distance from the vessel of **500 metres** when it is undertaking work and showing the appropriate shapes and lights in accordance with COLREGS Rule 18.
