#### 1. Jacket Installation

This NTM has been revised and re-issued on 02/09/2020 to include an additional vessel (the Normand Service) in the work scope. All other details remain unchanged from the original NTM.

Please be advised that Moray Offshore Windfarm (East) Limited (Moray East) commenced Jacket installation on all of the pre piled areas (shown in figure 1) using Seajacks Scylla from 27/06/2020 until further notice. Once the Jackets have been installed Boa Sub C will be utilised for grouting operations on the newly installed jackets and the Normand Energy will carry out the continuation of the soil plug removal. Further updates will be notified in the WNoO's.






Figure 2. Pre piled areas ready for jacket installation




Figure 3. Photo of Jackets to be installed.
